

Entry restrictions in Spain

Due to restrictions imposed by Spanish regulations in relation to the situation caused by COVID-19, **from 00:00 hours on 23 March 2020**, the authorities will only allow **entry into Spain if the passengers can prove that**:

- 1. They are a national of Spain
- 2. They are a **national of a European Union Member State** or Schengen Associated State and, **in addition**:
 - 1. you are going <u>directly</u> to your place of residence; or
 - 2. You are in one of the following categories: (1) Cross-border workers, (2) health or elderly care professionals on their way to work, (3) personnel engaged in the transport of goods, (4) personnel in the exercise of their work, (5) flying personnel required to carry out commercial air transport activities, (6) diplomatic, consular, international organisation, military personnel and members of humanitarian organisations, in the exercise of their duties; (7) Travelling for imperative family reasons duly accredited; or (8) Travelling for reasons of force majeure or necessity, or whose entry is permitted on humanitarian grounds which must be documented.

3. Even if they do not have Spanish or European Union nationality:

- 1. You are resident in the European Union or a Schengen Associated State and you are going <u>directly</u> to your place of residence or
- 2. You are a holder of a long-stay visa issued by a Member State or a Schengen Associated State and you are on your way there, or
- 3. You are in one of the following categories: (1) Cross-border workers, (2) health or elderly care professionals on their way to work, (3) personnel engaged in the transport of goods, (4) personnel in the exercise of their work, (5) flying personnel required to carry out commercial air transport activities, (6) diplomatic, consular, international organisation, military personnel and members of humanitarian organisations, in the exercise of their duties; (7) Travelling for imperative family reasons duly accredited; or (8) Travelling for reasons of force majeure or necessity, or whose entry is permitted on humanitarian grounds which must be documented.



Please note that if **they cannot provide sufficient evidence** in the opinion of the Spanish authorities of any of the above circumstances, **their entry into Spain may be denied** and they may be returned to the place of origin of their flight.
